Checked out items will now auto-renew on their due dates if eligible for renewal. This applies only to physical items owned by LDL following regular renewal policies. For example, if someone else is awaiting the item or the item has reached its maximum allowed renewals, it will not renew. Items borrowed from other libraries will not auto-renew at this time. If we have your email address on file, you will receive an email notice with the new due dates for your renewed items. To opt-out of the auto-renewal service, call us or stop in.
