Hoofbeats Through History: The Fire Horse

Join us on **Monday, September 16 at 6 PM** for Hoofbeats Through History: The Fire Horse, presented by Mary Chris Foxworthy, at the deAngeli branch.

For 60 years, the Fire Horse was a prominent feature in America. When the alarm sounded, the horses galloped out of the fire station, followed by crowds of spectators and children. As Loula Long Combs wrote, "If you have never seen a horse-drawn fire engine, you ain't seen nothing!"

Foxworthy is a passionate advocate for horses by preserving their history and bring their stories to life in print. She is the author of *The Hoofbeats Through History* book series for kids, including *Hark! Follow My Hoofbeats*, inspired by her horse HD Harkness becoming a Breyer model horse. Foxworthy says her lifelong love for horses was, "sparked by my grandfather's ownership of one of the last horse-drawn milk wagon creameries in the United States, [which] led me to fulfill my lifetime dream of owning a Morgan horse after college."

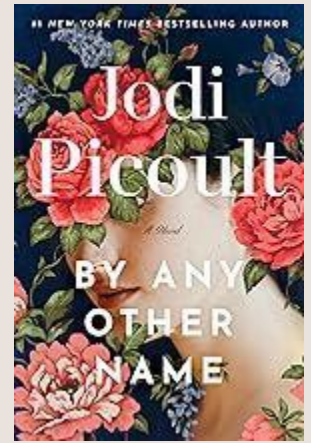
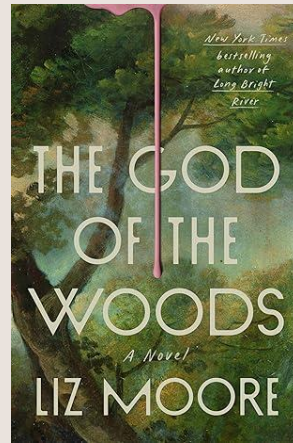
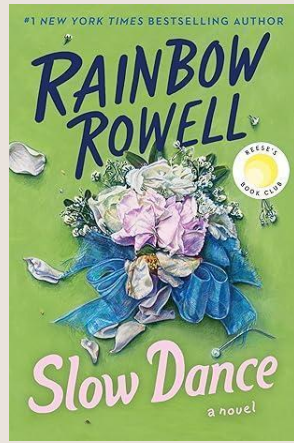
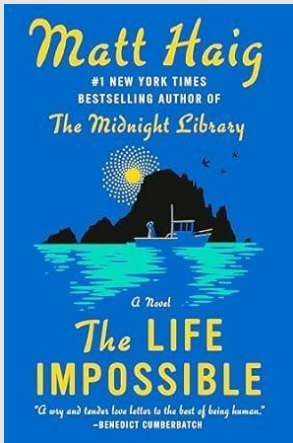
Nature on Nepessing
